



NEEDHAM TOWN HALL AND THE JAMES HUGH POWERS HALL: a Brief History

For Needham's first I3O years, town meetings were held wherever there was a large enough space. Most often, this meant at the Parish Meeting House, the town's only public building. In I838, Town Meeting looked into erecting a "town house" as a location for conducting town business. The result was a large room added to the town poorhouse, on the dividing line between Needham's East and West Parishes. This arrangement lasted until the West Parish split off in I881 to become Wellesley, and Needham lost the building.

The new town center needed a focal point, and in 1901, Town Meeting authorized a Town Hall to meet the increasingly urgent need for "proper and fitting accommodations" from which to conduct town business. The new Town Hall was completed in 1903 as a civic monument to Needham's Twentieth Century identity.

For its first 50 years, the Town Hall's large second-floor hall was the community's meeting place – not only for Town Meeting and official business, but also for community celebrations, military recruiting, theatrical and dance performances, and balls. These functions scattered to school gyms and auditoriums after the second floor was partitioned for office space in the 1950s.

By 2009 the Town Hall was in need of repair and critically short of space. Town Meeting approved the cost of a renovation and expansion, much of it paid for with Community Preservation Act funding. A large addition to the building created office and meeting space and allowed the second floor "Great Hall" to be returned to its original function as a meeting and event hall. As part of Needham's Tercentennial celebrations in the fall of 2011, the Great Hall was dedicated as the James Hugh Powers Hall, in honor of Mr. Powers' long and energetic service to Needham. The Hall now serves again as the site of town services, meetings and celebrations, including the Needham Bank Great Hall Concert Series, helping to expand the cultural and economic life of Needham. Now into its second century, Needham Town Hall is more than ever the civic and emotional heart of our town.

Peter Cincotti November 5, 2022 at 8:00 pm

88 keys, a bench and a mic. Give those things to Peter Cincotti and he can take you anywhere. Whether he is soloing over a song that showcases his jazz roots, or playing a catchy hook from one of his popular originals, Peter Cincotti blends genres while bringing active, rhythmic piano playing back into the landscape of modern music.



A born and bred New Yorker, Cincotti spent much of his childhood going to school during the day and playing clubs at night. Legendary music producer Phil Ramone was there one of those nights, a discovery that led Ramone to produce Peter's debut album which reached #I on the Billboard jazz charts, making I8-year old Cincotti the youngest artist ever to do so.

Since then, Peter has performed in some of the world's most prestigious venues from Carnegie Hall to L'Olympia in Paris, collaborated with artists ranging from Andrea Bocelli to David Guetta, has been featured in block-buster films such as Spiderman 2, represented the global fashion brands Ermenegildo Zegna and Tod's, and even appeared as himself in Season 3 of the hit Netflix series House of Cards.

Peter's experiences have shaped his music through the years, changing the layers of his sound and the dimensions of his style. Peter currently hosts a live stream show called 'That Friday Feeling with Peter' from his apartment in New York, where fans from around the world join him each week for drinks, talk, music and more, every Friday night at 6pm EST.

Peter's newest album, 88 Keys & Me, will mark his first record honoring some of the most influential piano men and women of all time, as well as some autobiographical originals. Whether he is blending influences from Nat King Cole to Billy Joel, Lady Gaga to John Lennon, or Bill Evans to Coldplay, Cincotti creates a kind of crazy glue between genres, revealing the hidden harmonies behind the songs we thought we knew.

RUTHIE FOSTER

March 4, 2023 at 8:00 pm

Award-winning artist Ruthie Foster has been nominated for (among others!) a Best Blues Album Grammy — three times in a row — seven Blues Music Awards, three Austin Music Awards, a Living Blues Critics' Award for Female Blues Artist of the Year, and "inspiring American Artist" as a United States Artists 2018 Fellow. Draw-



ing influence from legendary acts like Mavis Staples and Aretha Franklin, Foster developed a unique sound unable to be contained within a single genre. As Ruthie wraps her impeccably nuanced voice around each song, the wisdom of her selections, the strength of each arrangement, their near-seamless flow converge into yet another reminder that Foster's artistry really is in a league of its own.

AZTEC TWO-STEP 2.0

April 22, 2023 at 8:00 pm

Originating from a chance meeting at an "open mic night" in a Boston folk club in 1971, Rex Fowler and Neal Shulman formed Aztec Two-Step. Their albums helped usher the music of the 60's into the 1970's and beyond, leaving an indelible mark on the musical genre. For over forty years, Rex



and Neal impressed audiences with intelligent songwriting, dazzling acoustic lead guitar, and soaring two-part harmonies. Neal retired in 2018, but Rex continues to expand the band's legacy with fan favorites, forgotten gems and new compositions with the members of his new ensemble.





NEEDHAM PUBLIC SCHOOLS FINE AND PERFORMING ARTS

The Fine and Performing Arts Department is an integral component to the comprehensive, standards-based educational experience of every child enrolled in Needham Public Schools.


